

WEEK 1 | April 1-4

- Pray for the sick in our community, state, nation, and around the world as well as their families.
- Pray our supported missionaries (Information at Go2Grace.org/Missions), many of whom are experiencing this crisis in foreign lands.
- Pray for those who are especially vulnerable to this disease, that they would be protected and well cared for by others.
- Pray for your Pastors and Elders at Grace, that God would give them wisdom to lead during this difficult season of not being able to gather together.
- Pray that in His providence God would bring an end to this pandemic, that the spread would be stopped and lives would be saved.

WEEK 2 | April 5-11

- Pray that those who are fearful would be reminded of the truths of the Gospel, that “God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control” (2 Timothy 1:7).
- Pray for healthcare workers who are treating the sick, that the Lord would protect and strengthen them.
- Praise God for the atoning work of Jesus Christ – the Great Physician – who heals us from our sin and has given us eternal life.
- Pray that many who are hurting in this season would turn to Jesus Christ for salvation and hope.
- Pray for those who have lost their jobs during this crisis, that God would provide for them and their families.

WEEK 3 | April 12-18

- Rejoice in the Resurrection of Christ – He has risen indeed!
- Pray for our local, state, and national leaders that God would give them the wisdom to respond to the challenges posed by COVID-19.
- Pray for students and teachers who are having to adapt to this situation and continue their studies online.
- Ask God to reveal opportunities for you to love and serve your neighbors in tangible, Christ-exalting ways.
- Pray that Grace would be a church that displays the love of Christ to one another and to the community (John 13:34-35).

WEEK 4 | April 19-25

- Praise God as the sovereign Lord over all things; nothing occurs outside of His holy will.
- Pray that a spirit of generosity, both in you and in others, would take root and that “as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith” (Galatians 6:10).
- Ask God to give you opportunities to point others to the hope that is in you, and that they would respond to the Gospel in faith.
- Pray for other churches and ministries in our community, that God would give them wisdom as to how they can best minister to others during this time.
- Give thanks that “neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Romans 8:38-39).

WEEK 5 | April 26-30

- Pray for the body of Christ worldwide, that the church would step in during this unique time in our history and be the hands and feet of Jesus towards those in need.
- Pray for those who own small businesses in our church and community, that they would be able to weather this difficult season and rebound when it is over.
- Ask God that He would work in and through you to bear fruit for His kingdom during this season.
- Praise God that “while we were still sinners, Christ died for us” (Romans 5:8).
- Pray that each one of us would draw closer to Christ and make serving Him our highest priority.
