## WELL CHILD POLICY

We want to provide a healthy, safe environment for all of our children, so we ask that you do not bring your child into our care if you have observed any of the following from any in your household:

- Fever, vomiting or diarrhea (Note: Children should be free of a fever, vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before coming to children's ministry)
- Any symptom of scarlet fever, measles, mumps, chicken pox, or whooping cough
- Common cold – from onset of symptoms and one week thereafter
- Sore throat
- Coughing
- Lice
- Any unexplained rash
- Any skin infection such as boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Pink eye or other eye infection
- Thick green, yellow or constant nasal discharge
- Any other communicable disease

If a child has one of the above symptoms, the child will not be accepted into our care. If your child becomes ill while in our care, you will be notified promptly.

If your child is being treated with an antibiotic, he or she should have received treatment for at least 24 hours before coming into our care.

We will NOT administer medication of any kind.

For your child's protection, we ask our Nursery and Children's Ministry workers to follow these same guidelines.
